This year end report is in no special order. We have been very busy this past year. We were involved in many different activities and some we watched very closely. Such as, the Barn. We were involved in opposing water privatizing. If ten (10) people got up in front of the BOCC to oppose it, eight (8) were members of the CCC. We had an Informational Forum on Home Town Democracy. We didn't agree with the County on the \$750,000.00 grant for a water line to Wal-Mart on U.S. 19. We opposed the connection of Pine Ridge Blvd. to Turkey Oak. We are still watching the space needs scenario. We met with Susan Gill, Jeff Green, Janice Warren and Andy Houston on the subject. Ottawa Ave. is a serious situation that we are trying to stay on top of. Floral Village is another topic we are watching. The Old Hernando School situation is another topic. We are also watching the Affordable Housing Job proposed for the Library area of Beverly Hills. We also took a very interesting tour of The Tannery and then there was the Budget. They wouldn't dare.

The people of Citrus County are upset. We had a voter turnout about 5th of 6th highest in the state, but I think we were the only County to throw all the incumbents out of office.
