Minutes of General Meeting May 12, 2010

CALL TO ORDER: *President Theodora Rusnak*, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL: Secretary Rosella Hale called the roll of Associate Members and Member Organizations. A quorum was established.

GUEST SPEAKER: *Rep. Ron Schultz* gave an in-depth synopsis of the legislative year and presented his view of the Florida political process.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: It was moved and passed that the minutes from the April 2010 General Meeting are accepted as published. There was no correspondence.

TREASURER'S REPORT: The Treasurer, Carl Simpson, reported the balance as of May 12, 2010, as \$798.25.

COUNTY STAFF:

Sgt. Chris Evan, Sheriff's Office reminded the delegation to lock cars, don't leave expensive items in plain sight in cars. He additionally warned everyone of scams appearing in e-mail boxes.

Jenette Collins, Development Services, reported on development activity for the County. She also announced the anticipated reduction in the transportation segment of impact fees by the County Commissioners, expected to be discussed at the next BoCC meeting. Flood plain maps are being readied for inspection. Homeowners were encouraged to review at earliest possible convenience to determine if their homes were in newly identified flood-prone areas, or had been removed from same for insurance purposes.

Chuck Dixon, Director, Planning & Growth Management, CCSD, reported that 180 homeless children were being served by the Citrus County School District. A discussion of the options available to the county regarding usage and disposition of the Old Hernando (a.k.a. Lakeview) School building, now used as a community facility, ensued.

Environment and Natural Resources: *Chair Gus Krayner* announced that he has received a copy of the proposed Fertilizer Ordinance and the committee will be reviewing it for comment at a future BoCC meeting. The May ENR Committee meeting is cancelled due to the conflict with the Memorial Day holiday.

Governance Committees: *Chair Tom Mize* – Filed a written committee report. He further offered a report on the Public Forum conducted by the Council on the proposed Amendment 4, Saturday, May 8.
